- Continually improve our environmental impacts and performance through training, setting, assessing, reviewing and reporting against our environmental objectives and targets.
- Communicate this policy to all workers and make the policy available upon request to the general public including on project sites to demonstrate our commitment to responsible environmental management.
- Pro-actively identifying, managing and reporting on environmental impacts and incidents.
- Be proactive in monitoring our potential significant environmental impacts by regular testing of plant and vehicles to assess emission and noise pollution levels and the impact on the health of our workers.
- Implement appropriate spill prevention, training and clean up response processes to prevent and limit any potential environmental damage.
- Constantly review our operations and work practices to minimise our potential significant environmental impacts including emissions, noise pollution and potential soil or water contamination.
- Actively promote and encourage the adoption of ecologically sustainable work practices and operations, including the reuse and recycling of resources, reduction of energy use and water usage where possible.
- Promoting compliance with the Federal Government principles of ecological sustainable development and continuous improvement in pollution prevention.

Management and Supervisors will ensure that they:

- Implement an environmental management system that complies with all relevant legislative, regulatory and other requirements.
- Provide the appropriate human resources, skills, technology and financial resources to ensure our environmental management objectives can be met.
- Setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets and performance to drive continual improvement.
- Implementing measures that support the adoption of ecologically sustainable work practices.
